Policies/Procedures

Full NFPA compliant structural firefighting or technical rescue PPE (including eye/hand/foot protection) must be worn by all students participating in hands-on skills stations.

A chief officer's signature is required to confirm members are authorized to attend this training. This requirement applies whether members are attending as a department or individually.
